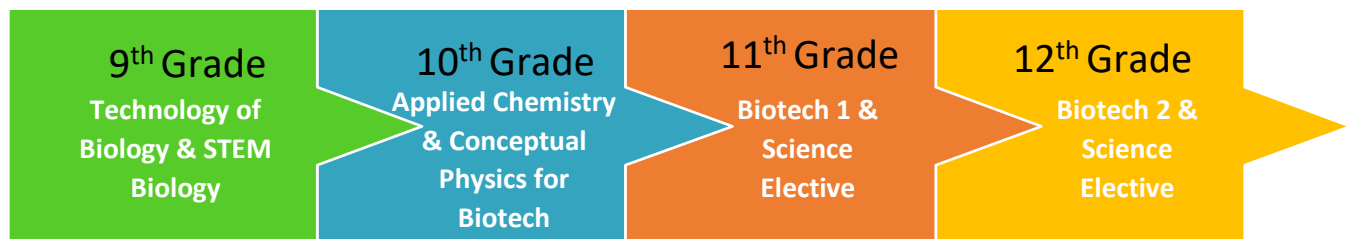

BIOTECHNOLOGY PATHWAY

APPLICATIONS ARE REQUIRED FOR PROGRAM PLACEMENT

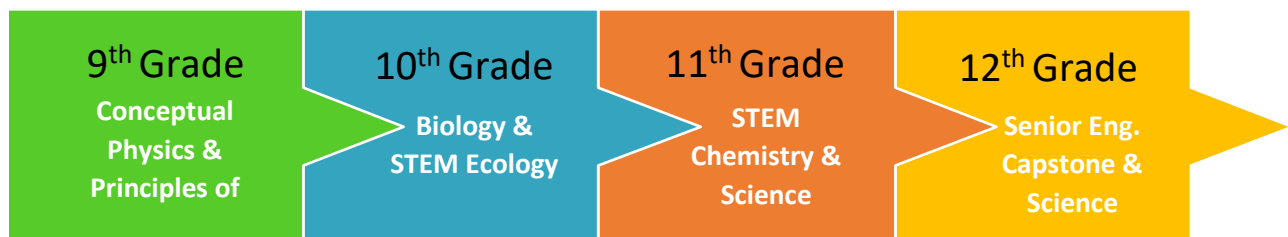
The STEM Marin Biotechnology Program is a college and career prep pathway focused on Biotechnology. Students learn about basic lab techniques, products, the biotech industry, bioethics and careers in biotechnology. Students have work-based learning opportunities like guest speakers and job shadowing. Some classes will be articulated with introduction to Biotechnology at College of Marin and Solano Community College. Students will get college credit for taking these classes at San Marin.



ENGINEERING PATHWAY
